

SedonaWeb and PCI Compliance: Prepare for PCI DSS 4.0

Please read this information carefully to ensure your customer portal software is compliant with [PCI DSS 4.0](#), the latest version of the global data security standard for credit card processing developed by the [PCI Security Standards Council](#).

My organization uses SedonaWeb 1. What do I need to do?

SedonaWeb 1 is NOT compliant with PCI DSS 4.0. Using non-PCI compliant software is in breach of your merchant account contract with your payment processor and puts your organization at risk.

To prepare for PCI DSS 4.0, we strongly urge you to migrate to our next-generation customer portal, SedonaWeb 2, which is fully compliant with the latest standard.

My organization uses SedonaWeb 2. What do I need to do?

The latest version of SedonaWeb 2 ([version 1.50](#)) is compliant with PCI 4.0 and is now available. All you need to do is update your software to comply with the new standard. Please [open a support case](#) in the Bold Group support portal to begin your software update.

Who must be PCI compliant?

Any organization that accepts, handles, stores, or transmits cardholder data must be PCI compliant, no matter the size of the business or number of transactions. That means any merchant that accepts debit or credit card payments must comply.

How do I become PCI compliant?

Your payment processing company certifies your PCI compliance through an annual validation process. You will be asked to provide documentation, which may include a self-assessment questionnaire (SAQ), a report from a Qualified Security Assessor (QSA), and a vulnerability scan.

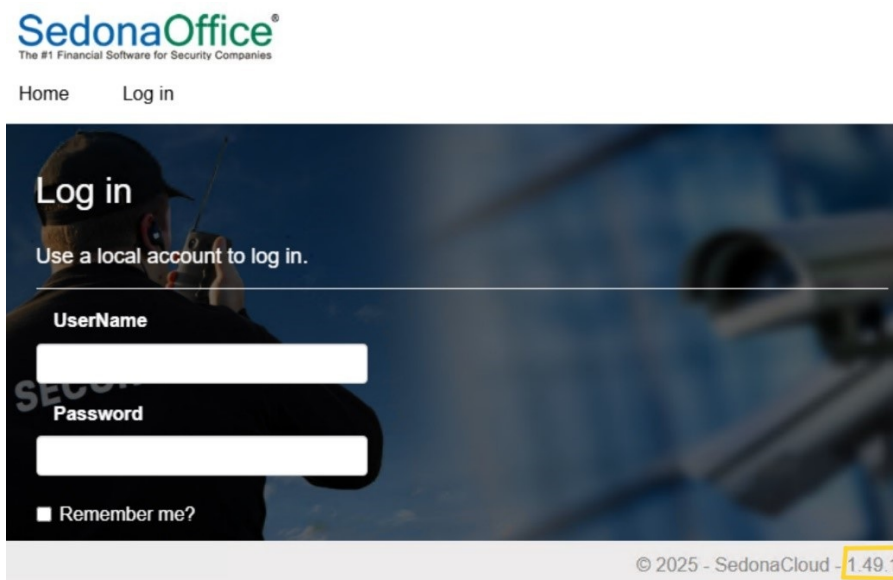
When will SedonaWeb 2.0 version 1.50 be released?

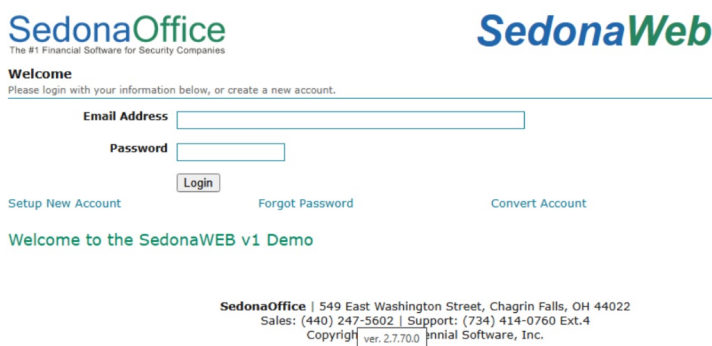
You can prepare for the release by updating to the latest version of [SedonaOffice \(6.2.0.19\)](#) if you have not already done so.

In SedonaWeb 2, you can find the version number in the footer.



In SedonaWeb 1 (legacy) you can find the version number by hovering over the footer.



What version of SedonaOffice do I need to be operating in order to update to the latest version of SedonaWeb 2?

You need to be operating the latest version of [SedonaOffice \(6.2.0.19\)](#) before you can update to SedonaWeb 2.0 version 1.50.
