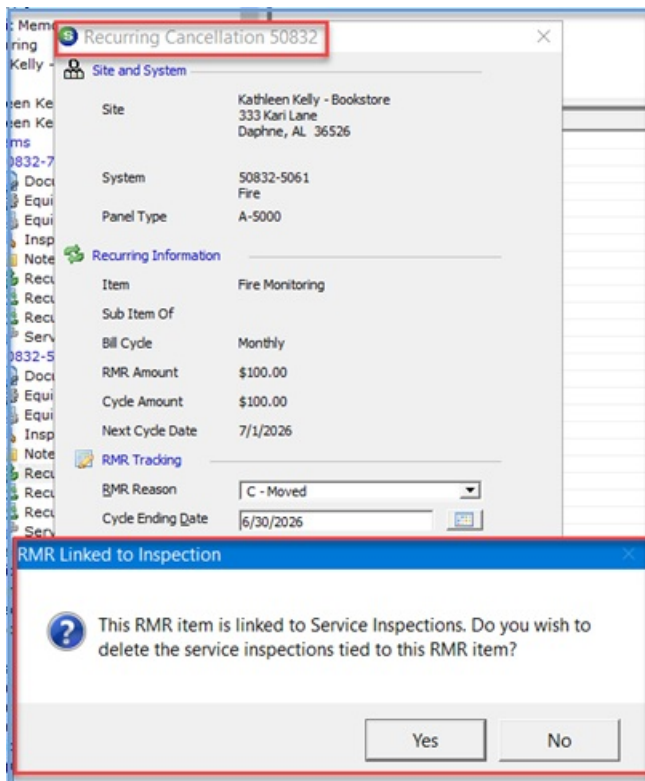

The system will ask whether you would like to delete the Inspection Record tied to that recurring line.

If you select **Yes**, the linked Inspection Record will be terminated.

If you select **No**, then you may want to review the Inspection Record and update the billing method.
